

MEETS Entry Procedure/Scratching

We will be operating an "Opt-in" entry policy whereby we will:

- Email meet information with "commit" or decline deadline
- Families Must OPT IN for each meet
- Information emailed as soon as it is received. May be a very short registration period.
- Permit families to select their swimmer's events (retaining coaches final approval or changes!)
- We will ONLY enter swimmers who have "committed" to attend the specific meet
- Once the deadline passes, NO REFUNDS CAN BE GIVEN
- Meets may be invoiced prior to competition.

Meets are "optional" and there are no guarantees that our entries will be "accepted" at all meets...regardless of best efforts...

Volunteering meets and more

Check Your Email every day prior to a meet!

Parent Volunteers are an essential part of ALL meets! 35+ volunteers required to run a single session: Timers, officials, marshalls, runners, hospitality No Experience Necessary for most jobs (except for Officials)

If your child is entered in a meet, expect that you may have to volunteer. Sign up early to get the spot you want

JAC Team Hosted Meets: (Approximately 1 per season (Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer)

- All hands on deck, ALL families with swimmer entered are expected to volunteer in some way.
- Job Signup will go live at least 1 week prior, and close Wednesday prior
- Open spots will be assigned on Thursday: # of swimmers, past volunteerism, meet/session needs

Once job signup closed or ASSIGNED, it is the family's responsibility to fulfill or find a replacement, Great reason to get to know your fellow swim families!

NO SHOWS ARE A BIG PROBLEM! Make every effort to find a cover AND communicate with Volunteer Coordinator, Coaches focus is on kids, don't make a missing timer their problem


